E079 - Initial Discussion with the Patient

Service rendered to a patient who currently smokes by the primary care physician most responsible for the patient's ongoing care.

Fee Value:
\$15.55 (in person/video)
\$13.20 (phone)
Limit:
Once per 365 days

1. Ask the patient the following questions:

- Are you a smoker?
- Do you plan on quitting?
- If yes, when do you plan on quitting by?

2. E079 is an add on code that can be billed with: A001, A003, A004, A005, A006, A007, A008, A905, K005, K007, K013, K017, K130, K131, K132, P003, P004, P005, P008, W001, W002, W003, W004, W008, W010, W104, W107, W109, W121.

OSCAR PRO TIP!

Add a notification reminder for recalling patients in the EMR.

Manage your patient recalls by creating a tickler after the appointment with the patient. The tickler can be set to a future date and your staff can reach out to book a follow up appointment.


OSCAR PRO TIP!

Create a flow sheet or measurement group in the EMR.

To track smoking cessation for patients, you can either create a flow sheet or measurement group.

Create a Flow Sheet

1. Navigate to Administration > System Management > Create a New Flowsheet.
2. Enter a name and ICD-9 trigger code.
3. Once created, the flow sheet can be assigned measurements to track. The ICD-9 trigger code such as the 3051 would need to be entered in the patient's disease registry part of their eChart (this will also come into play for the reporting).



Create a Measurement Group

A measurement group can be created and assigned to a flow sheet, or you may just use the measurement group.



OSCAR PRO TIP!

Generate a report for smoking cessation recall patients.

To generate a report, patients would need to be registered with the ICD-9 code in the Disease Registry of the eChart.



Need Help?
DoctorCare can generate a recall list of smokers from your billing history.

Create a custom Report by Template (Administration > Reports > Report by Template) to pull up a list of these patients at any time.

Here is an example of a report called Disease Registry Look Up. This could be modified for instance to include last appointment, or last billed a specific service code. The query will search for Smoking Cessation patients and ones that would need to be called back for a follow up appointment.

K039 - Follow Up Visit

The smoking cessation follow up service rendered by a primary care physician can be billed up to 2 times in the 12 months following E079 that is dedicated to a discussion of smoking cessation.

Note: This must be a dedicated smoking cessation counselling session (visit is not time-based).

Q042 - Counselling Fee

Q042 is an incentive paid alongside the K039 for rostered patients under the FHO, FHG, FHN, CCM payment models.

Create a Super Code to always bill the Q042 with the K039.

Smoking Cessation K039+Q042

Common Error & Explanation Codes

M1 – Max fee allowed for these services has been reached

You can only bill the smoking cessation codes a set number of times per year. If you exceed this limit within a 365-day period from the last processed fee code, it will be processed at a rate of \$0.

A36 – Claimed by other practitioner

Another practitioner billed the smoking cessation fee, resulting in its processing at \$0.

PAA – No initial fee previously paid

This error occurs when billing K039/Q042 without an E079 within the last 365 days. To resolve, submit an E079 along with the visit code.

DF – Corresponding fee code has not been claimed or was approved at zero

Either the E079 or the K039 code was billed alongside a code with which it cannot be billed.
